

Welcome to Red House. We hope you have an enjoyable stay.

This sheet is designed to give you information on where all facilities are and where you can and cannot go. Please look at the map, printed overleaf, to help you understand where things are. Also please remember that people live at Red House and they are used to peace and quiet.

FACILITIES

Toilets>Showers	Marked 13 on the map. The green "pods" are in the barn adjacent to the main site. They are unisex and big enough for family use. More WCs are available, marked 19 on the map.
Water	This is available from the taps adjacent to your pitch or the point marked 15 on the map. Please don't use the tap on the gate post of the Deer Park as this is for horses only. Red House water comes from a borehole on the grounds. It is tested regularly for purity and is renowned for its tea making qualities.
Rubbish	Please put your rubbish in closed plastic bags into the bins provided by the gate to the Deer Park. There are containers for recycling tins, bottles, plastics and newspapers. Please don't leave large items that don't fit in the bins.
Waste Disposal	The septic tank is marked 16 on the map. Please pour waste into the chamber with the black steel curved handles next to the bright galvanized steel lid of the tank. PLEASE DO NOT PUT SANITARY ITEMS INTO THIS CHAMBER - IT WILL BLOCK IT!
Grey Water	Waste from washing-up and showers can go straight into the drain adjacent to your pitch or in drain next to the water tap (No 15 on map).

PLACES WHERE YOU CAN AND CANNOT GO

There are many miles of footpaths and bridlepaths around Red House giving access to the River Ouse - enjoy! There are some excellent circular walks upstream to Moor Monkton and downstream to the Poppletons. There is also a right of way through Redhouse Wood and a permissive path going directly from the estate to the River Ouse. (See separate walks map.) On the map printed overleaf public and private areas are marked. Most private areas are fenced and gated but this is not possible in all cases, so please take care not to wander. Please be extra careful to keep out of stables and their associated yards. The Chapel is open during daylight hours

We have many horses and ponies here at livery and and some of them are easily frightened by dogs so please keep them on a lead at all times.

Livery yards are strictly out of bounds at all times.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Swimming pool	This is open June to August inclusive but is often open a week or two before and after. This depends on the length of the summer!
Tennis court	The entrance to it is through the gate next to the fish ponds. Please lower the net after use as the tension tends to pull the posts out of the ground. (<i>open from 1st May - 1st October - weather permitting!</i>)
Ponds	These are situated by the tennis court, Moat Field & Deer Park adjacent to the caravan areas. Please be aware that these ponds are of varying depths and are dangerous for children to play in.
Livestock	Horses, ponies and sheep graze behind fences on the fields. Please do not enter the fields or feed the animals (particularly the horses with cut grass as this can cause serious illness). Horses are unpredictable and easily frightened and, if they are startled, can bite and kick.
<u>REMEMBER TO KEEP OUT OF STABLES & STABLE YARDS</u>	
<u>Please keep your dogs on the lead, there are horses, children, cats, dogs, and chickens on the estate.</u>	
Trees	Adam & Eve , the ancient oak trees beside the old stable block are <u>not to be climbed</u> as they are approximately 500 years old now and some parts are too rotten to be safely climbed.
Fishing	Day tickets are available from the office. These allow you to fish on the River Ouse downstream of Red House Landing. Cost £6 per person per day. (Close season 15th March - 15th June)
Shopping	Milk is delivered on Mon/Wed/Fri/Sat - to order, ask at the main house. See the accompanying Local Amenities Map for shops in the area. The nearest shops are on the A59 towards Harrogate at Skip Bridge Service Station or towards York in Poppleton (turn left at the Red Lion and there is a Nisa store on the Green). Our nearest 24hr superstore is Tesco at Clifton Moor - turn left onto the York by-pass towards York (North).

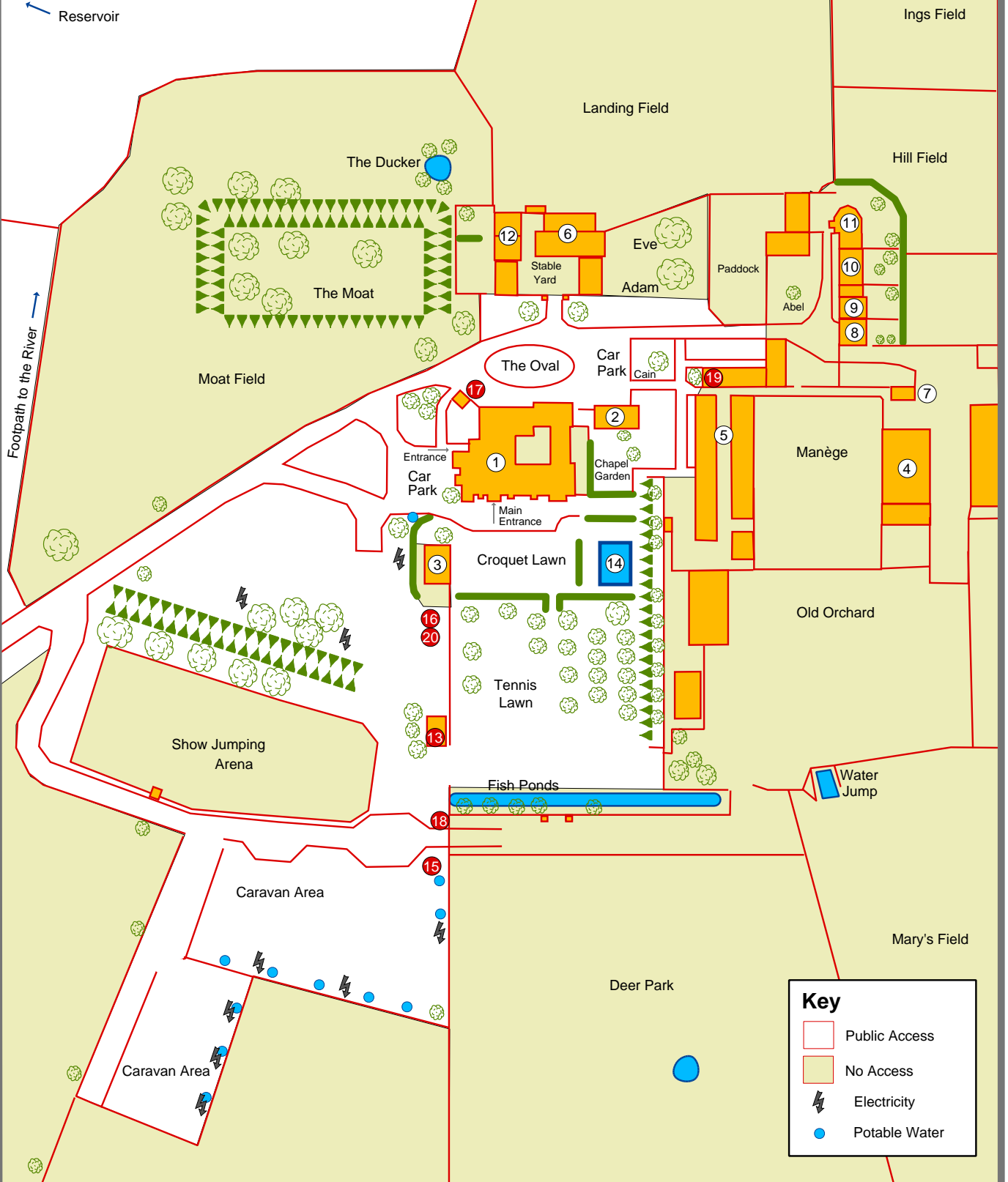
